Stephen Falk joined Northwestern Memorial Foundation (NMF) in October of 2001. He currently holds the position of President of NMF. Prior to joining NMF, he served as Director of Development and Director of Planned Giving at Henry Ford Health System in Detroit. Prior to healthcare fundraising, he served in higher education capacities in both Michigan and Illinois.

Mr. Falk has served in numerous advisory and leadership capacities within his profession. Currently, Mr. Falk is a member of the Midwestern Association for Healthcare Philanthropy (AHP) Cabinet. Prior to coming to Chicago, he served as President of the Michigan Association for Healthcare Philanthropy. In addition, he was elected President of the Planned Giving Roundtable of Southeastern Michigan, a group of nonprofit and professional legal and financial executives who promote charitable giving through estate planning. Mr. Falk participated in the writing of a national text on fundraising in 2005, and has presented, nationally, on 19 occasions since joining NMF.
